YTD 2012 (thru April) new registrations in the state were up 21.2%. U.S. market was up 6.4%.

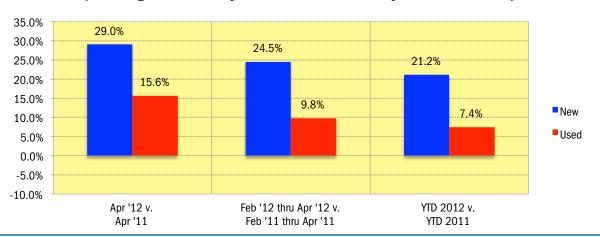
Used vehicle market increased 15.6% in April 2012 (vehicles seven years old or newer) and was up 7.4%, year-to-date.

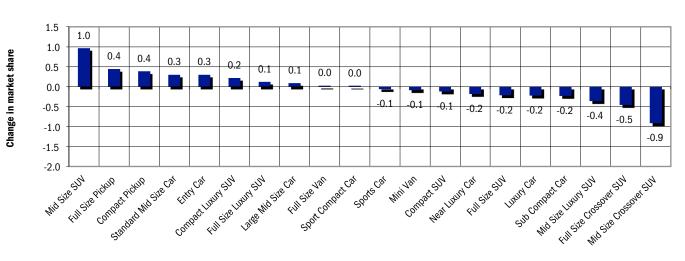

Change in New Vehicle Segment Market Share - YTD 2012 thru April v. YTD 2011

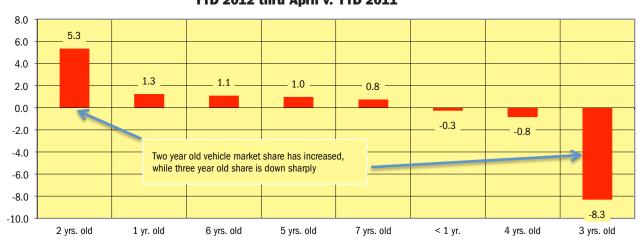

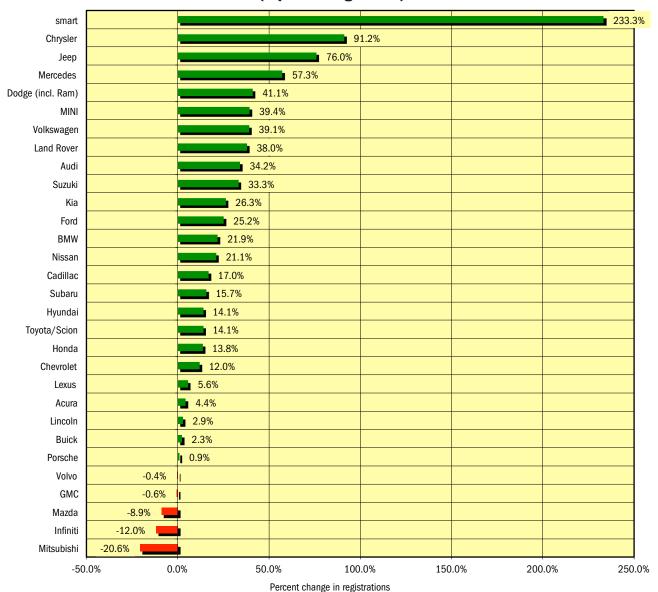
