Quick Facts

New retail car and light truck registrations in the state increased 10.9% in October 2015 versus a year earlier.


New registrations in the state were up 8.3% during the first ten months of 2015 compared to a year earlier.

Used vehicle market was up 13% in October 2015 (vehicles seven years old or newer), and improved 6.7% for the first ten months of this year.

Chrysler, Lincoln, Porsche, Buick, GMC, Subaru, Volvo, and Mazda new vehicle registrations increased by more than 15% so far this year.

Data measures new vehicle registrations in the state. Monthly recording of registrations occurs when the data is processed by the DMV.



Please keep in mind that monthly registration figures can occasionally be subject to fluctuations, resulting in over or under estimation of actual results. This usually occurs due to processing delays by governmental agencies. For this reason, the year-to-date figures will typically be more reflective of market results. Reported monthly registration totals for August and September of 2014 were impacted by title processing delays by the DMV. Registration figures were modified by Auto Outlook to more accurately reflect the level of new vehicle sales in these months. Change in New Vehicle Segment Market Share - YTD 2015 thru October vs. YTD 2014




