Quick Facts

Colorado new vehicle registrations increased 4.5% in September '13 vs. 2012.

New registrations in the state during the first nine months of this year increased 12.5% compared to a year earlier.


Used vehicle market was down 1.5% in September 2013 (vehicles seven years old or newer), and improved 3.1%, year-to-date.

Three year old vehicle market share increased 3.2 share points.

Dodge, Ram, BMW, and Porsche new vehicle registrations each increased more than 30% during the first nine months of this year.

Data measures new vehicle registrations in the state. Monthly recording of registrations occurs when the data is processed by the DMV.




Change in Used Vehicle Market Share by Age of Vehicle YTD '13 thru September v. YTD '12 thru September
